It's good for what ails you - well, in moderation :-) An excessive activity that, thankfully, seems to be quite harmless is **SINGING!** ⁽²⁾ Which, **as long as it's done correctly**, is FUN and definitely good for what ails you!

July is Section Appreciation Month!

Last week we spent some time exploring the challenges - and rewards - of singing **LEAD**. Here are a few notes by way of a memory refresher (or in case you were MIA):

- Breathe **TOGETHER** using a high, shared space.
- Sing with a free, relaxed, "open" tone for a blended unit sound (relaxed jaw, lifted soft palate, tongue resting on lower gum ridge).
- Use a continuous mix of "head" and "chest" registers to sing with "ONE VOICE."
- Sing a smooth, continuous vocal line minimizing "white space" between lyrics.
- Use proper breath support for an even vocal tone with minimal vibrato.
- Avoid pressure or force in the voice so other parts can easily blend.
- Be aware when you **don't** have the melody and **back off**.

- Understand tuning with other parts know your part well enough that you can **LISTEN** to the chords.
- Leads and Baris generally share the middle of the chords; should be equally solid on both parts.
- LEAD with emotion and heart to "tell the story" of the song.

Don't be fooled by thinking that **LEADS** have the easiest part! A group can only be as good as its lead section, so it comes with a lot of responsibility! And, by the way, these tips are for **EVERYONE** because the HARMONY PARTS are often featured singing some or all of a song's melody line.

HURRAY for the LEADS!!!

Tonight, we'll be focusing on singing **BASS** (with tips that will be helpful for the other parts too!) I'll see you there! Love,

NEW RECYCLE GUIDELINES

Please bring your aluminum cans, plastic bottles, and glass bottles to rehearsal and load them in my car! Examples include water bottles, soda cans, and beer cans. This is a great ongoing fundraiser for the chorus!

**The only glass bottles accepted are water bottles, soda bottles and BEER bottles or any bottle that has the CRV sign on it. NO Wine and other hard liquor bottles as they are not allowed.

PLEAS DO NOT BRING prescription bottles, yogurt or Ensure bottles, food containers, like mayonnaise or pickle jars or canned- goods cans or take-out containers, honey containers, cooking oil containers or other things like that. Bring only **California Redemption Value (CRV)** beverage cans and bottles.

I will **no longer** be accepting UNSORTED recycling materials. Cans, plastic bottles and glass bottles must be separated and placed in a plastic trash bag. I will **not accept bags that are not tied closed**. Open bags are not acceptable because

they fall out of the bag and all over my car. If you only have 2 or 3 cans and lots of plastic bottles, you can put 2 or 3 cans in a small bag and then stick that small bag in your big bag of bottles.
