- Basics: Pants (wide/narrow leg, "dressy" jeans/leggings ok), Skirt, Dress, Top (shirt, blouse, tunic, "dressy" tee)
- Optional additions: Jacket, Vest, Bolero, Cardigan, tie, belt. hat (b/w Fedora/Small Brimmed Hat, Beret, Headband)
- Footwear: Keds, Converse or similar casual shoe style (white/yellow and/or black)
- Yellow Accents: Add **ONE** of the following: scarf, necktie, bow, flower pin, bold jewelry piece, hat band, socks
- Sunglasses OK if performing outside.

NO shorts, mini-skirts, sleeveless/tank, halter or cropped style tops, yoga/workout wear, sweatpants/tops, hoodies, faded black denim/fabrics, large hats, baseball caps.

NO patterns other than the optional b/w stripe or accent edge banding NO sparkle, sequins, glitter or shiny fabrics.

Wear what works for you! Have fun with it and feel free to show off your individual personality and style!


For the actual photoshoot we may need to edit your look while we are there so Kate can get great shots of us as a group. I know you'll be good sports as always!

RECYCLE GUIDELINES

Please bring your aluminum cans, plastic bottles, and glass bottles to rehearsal and load them in my car! Examples include water bottles, soda cans, and beer cans. This is a great ongoing fundraiser for the chorus!

**The only glass bottles accepted are water bottles, soda bottles and BEER bottles or any bottle that has the CRV sign on it. NO Wine and other hard liquor bottles as they are not allowed.

PLEAS DO NOT BRING prescription bottles, yogurt or Ensure bottles, food containers, like mayonnaise or pickle jars or canned- goods cans or take-out containers, honey containers, cooking oil containers or other things like that. Bring only California Redemption Value (CRV) beverage cans and bottles.

I will no longer be accepting UNSORTED recycling materials. Cans, plastic bottles, and glass bottles must be separated and placed in a plastic trash bag. I will not accept bags that are not tied closed. Open bags are not acceptable because they fall out of the bag and all over my car. If you only have 2 or 3 cans and lots of plastic bottles, you can put 2 or 3 cans in a small bag and then stick that small bag in your big bag of bottles.
