Hi, Everyone,

Sooo, just when we thought it was safe to "get back in the water"....

If you haven't been keeping up with your email inbox you need to know first of all that **REHEARSAL TONIGHT is CANCELED.** Over the last week we've had several members test positive for Covid so it's best for all that we take tonight off to rest, recover or enjoy a Monday Night out on the Town! Of course, you're always welcome to take advantage of the unexpected "down time" to work on your music??? Hmmm - there's an idea!!!

To my knowledge those who tested positive did not become seriously ill and are all doing well. But it's clear that the virus is still with us and is likely not going away anytime soon. It does seem to have become generally less dangerous - but possibly more contagious - which I'm told is how viruses mutate to stay around? In any event, we want to be sure we can continue singing together with minimal risk. So next Monday we'll be back outside **on the Patio with masks encouraged.**

So where were we before this unplanned interference? Well, we were busy focusing on **HOW to SING TENOR!** Here are a few follow up notes from last week's rehearsal and, as always, there are helpful tips in here for all voice parts!

NOTES for TENORS:

- Relax, drop the shoulders, lift the chest, keep your chin level and **BREATHE!**
- Sing with energy, control and **VOCAL FREEDOM** no tension in the throat
- Produce a straight, consistent, clear tone with **NO VIBRATO**
- Tenor is the "Icing on the Chorus Cake" sing pretty!
- Tenor notes MUST be sung absolutely IN TUNE!!!
- Think of it as singing a continuous **DUET with the LEADS**
- When singing below the lead try to match their volume and resonance
- Don't fear the HIGH NOTES be in control of your instrument!
- Lift the soft palate (roof of mouth) to create open space (rather than dropping the jaw)
- **Light** and **clear** is generally better than LOUD a little tenor goes a long way!
- Sing with your "whole voice" using a mix of registers for a smooth, connected sound
- Minimize hard consonants remember you are are singing a harmony part!
- Know when you are on the **3rd or 7th** notes they should be tuned **HIGH** and **LIGHT**
- Know and understand when you have the **melody** and take the lead!
- LISTEN for the MELODY be sure you can HEAR the CHORDS for accurate tuning
- Be aware of "losing your voice" in the overall sound once you get used to it, IT FEELS GOOD!

Next week we'll continue focusing on our VOCAL SKILLS and start to prep for our upcoming PERFORMANCES! If you haven't let Linda know your availability, DO IT NOW!

RECYCLE GUIDELINES

Please bring your aluminum cans, plastic bottles, and glass bottles to rehearsal and load them in my car! Examples include water bottles, soda cans, and beer cans. This is a great ongoing fundraiser for the chorus!

**The only glass bottles accepted are water bottles, soda bottles and BEER bottles or any bottle that has the CRV sign on it. NO Wine and other hard liquor bottles as they are not allowed.

PLEAS DO NOT BRING prescription bottles, yogurt or Ensure bottles, food containers, like mayonnaise or pickle jars or canned- goods cans or take-out containers, honey containers, cooking oil containers or other things like that. Bring only California Redemption Value (CRV) beverage cans and bottles.

I will no longer be accepting UNSORTED recycling materials. Cans, plastic bottles, and glass bottles must be separated and placed in a plastic trash bag. I will not accept bags that are not tied closed. Open bags are not acceptable because

they fall out of the bag and all over my car. If you only have 2 or 3 cans and lots of plastic bottles, you can put 2 or 3 cans in a small bag and then stick that small bag in your big bag of bottles.
