### **FROM L.A. TO THE DOUBLETREE HOTEL, BAKERSFIELD**

1. Find your way to the I-405 San Diego Fwy NORTH.
2. Continue on I-405 NORTH to I-5 NORTH.
3. Take I-5 NORTH for 61 miles merging onto CA-99.
4. Continue on CA-99 NORTH to Bakersfield/Fresno for 26 miles.
5. Take CA-58 Rosedale Hwy. Exit, LEFT onto Rosedale Hwy.
6. Drive 1/2 mile on Rosedale Hwy. to Camino Del Rio Ct. Turn LEFT.
7. Turn LEFT into hotel parking lot.

3. Drive to Oak St., and turn **RIGHT**.
4. Go to Truxtun Ave., and turn **LEFT**.
5. It will be a few miles down on the **RIGHT**.

### **Friday Afternoon/Evening Clothing**

**If you plan to be at the Rabobank Auditorium on Friday to watch the Quartet Contest, please plan to wear a smart casual outfit of your own choice in black/white with red and/or pink accents.**

### **SATURDAY COSTUMES**

**Pink, red, or white T-shirt and bandana**

**Accessories:** belt, chunky jewelry, hair accessory, in red, pink, white, or black

### **TOP OPTIONS To Be Worn Over CHORUS T-SHIRT**

White cotton shirt with collar, rolled up sleeve

Can be tucked in, tied at the waist or tunic length worn with pants

### **BOTTOM OPTIONS**

Plain white jeans, rolled up at ankle

White capri pants (50's style)

Black dance leggings (worn only with long tunic top)

Plain white swing skirt (no crinoline)

Plain black swing skirt (no crinoline)

White ankle socks (optional), can have lace or ruffle

White chorus tennies or b/w chorus spectator shoes

## **DANCERS**

**Checked swing skirt**, black bow belt, red blouse, bandana, white tennies, ankle socks, pink crinoline

**Red swing skirt**, black bow belt, pink blouse, bandana, white tennies, ankle socks, white crinoline

**Same accessory choices as above**

## **Personal Items**

Very small purse (size of quart-size Ziploc bag) to take with you for the day but not on stage, not part of costume

Clothes and personal sundries, etc. for the rest of the weekend  
Makeup remover and your own washcloths to remove makeup

## MAKEUP FOR STAGE

See *Sharon Savene* for any questions about makeup colors or application.

1. Begin with a thoroughly-cleansed face. Lightly moisturize if skin is dry.
2. Use a concealer or cover stick to even complexion if necessary.
3. FOUNDATION: Apply your own foundation with a sponge to hairline, on neck, under chin, on ears, and any exposed skin down to the neckline.
4. EYELINER: Apply black eyeliner or pencil above eyelashes and to the bottom of the eye, under the eyelashes.
5. MASCARA AND FALSE EYELASHES: Apply black mascara to darken upper and lower lashes. False eyelashes are optional.
6. EYESHADOW: Apply a light sandy color over entire eyelid to brow line. Apply dark purple color up to crease and outer edge of brow bone. It should show even when eye is open.
7. BROW PENCIL: Feather in eyebrows using a color to match your eyebrows or hair color.
8. CHEEK COLOR: Apply your own cheek color on the “apple” of the cheek and up over cheekbone.
9. LIPS: **Apply bright red or bright pink lipstick (your choice)**. Optional: Use red/pink lip pencil if you have a lot of creases in the lips.
10. NAIL POLISH: Manicure: None, **bright red, bright pink** or French are permitted.  
**Pedicure: N/A, closed-toed shoes only on stage, so any color is okay.**
11. NO PERFUME OR SCENTED HAIRSPRAY!

## **NOTES FROM CAROLINE**

1. Have a BLAST!
2. Please remember we are all there representing our Chorus. Be mindful of passing comment on the other performers “in public”. Be kind, generous and humble – even when it’s hard to resist saying what you really think!
3. Be supportive of ALL the competitors at ALL times. Let’s show how much we appreciate everyone’s efforts.
4. Please arrive PROMPTLY as needed per the above schedule. If something comes up and you can’t get to where you are supposed to be, please call or text me at 310-780-0177. Be prepared – we don’t want to board the bus and leave anyone behind!!
5. Friendly reminder – no “Fifth Wheeling” allowed (singing along with quartets around the hotel and at the afterglow).
6. Have a BLAST!
